

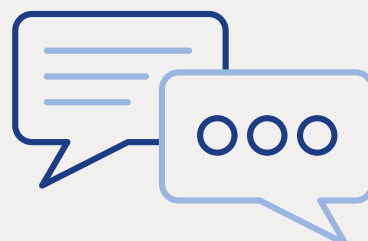
Five Examples From



Electionland FROM PROPUBLICA

1. MISINFORMATION

In 2016, ProPublica reported on an Urban Outfitters tweet that linked to **incorrect requirements**, stating that voters needed a voter registration card to vote. The tweet was later deleted.



2. IN-PERSON VOTING

In 2018, the Omaha World-Herald reported on an Electionland tip about a Nebraska poll worker telling a voter she couldn't vote if she was using a cell phone. Election officials said later on that **cell phones are allowed at polling places**.

3. VOTER ACCESS

Also in 2018, Electionland partner Houston Chronicle reported on confusion at a local HBCU, as **thousands of students** could have had their voter registrations jeopardized because they registered at the wrong address.



4. LIVE REPORTING

On Election Day in 2018, the Electionland team found that **damp ballots** (it was raining) caused scanners to malfunction.
